

# CAMP WOW STAFF PACKING LIST

## REQUIRED:

- Bible and any other quiet time material
- Storage containers for clothes (Rubbermaid drawers, tubs, etc.) You are living with other people so you can't keep your clothes on the floor.
- Bedding (sheets, sleeping bag, pillow, blankets)
- Modest swimsuits (one piece for girls, girls must wear swim shorts when on duty) LIFEGUARDS PLEASE BRING BLACK OR RED SWIMSUITS.
- Modest shorts: Must be longer than Nike Fit/running shorts.
- Clothes and shoes that you don't mind ruining this summer. We give you 4 Camp WOW shirts that you rotate wearing during camp. You need stuff you can get dirty during Work Week and clothes for evenings and outdoor activities.
- Bathroom Necessities (soap, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, towels, etc.)
- Laundry Stuff (detergent & fabric softener). We have washing machines in the commons area, but we do not provide detergent.
- Fun costumes for arrivals (we dress up crazy to greet campers, so be creative)
- Clothes for Late Night Parties Examples below. You don't have to have all of the stuff listed, it's just a list of ideas. Bring what you have! There are tons of leftover costumes at camp that you can have or borrow.
  - Western: jeans, plaid shirts, boots, cowboy hat, belt buckle, bandana
  - Black Light: stuff that glows in black lights, neon items like socks, shirts, headbands, etc..
  - Luau: Hawaiian shirt, grass skirt, Bermuda shorts, leis
  - Retro: Anything from the 50's-90's.
- Sunscreen and Bugspray
- Medication Please submit a list of prescription medication to management.
- We also strongly suggest allergy meds, pain relievers, and any other common OTC meds you use regularly. We have the craziest allergens in the world! We also provide general first aid and medical supplies in the office for staff use.
- Good Attitudes. Remember we get to serve the Lord!!!

## SUGGESTED:
